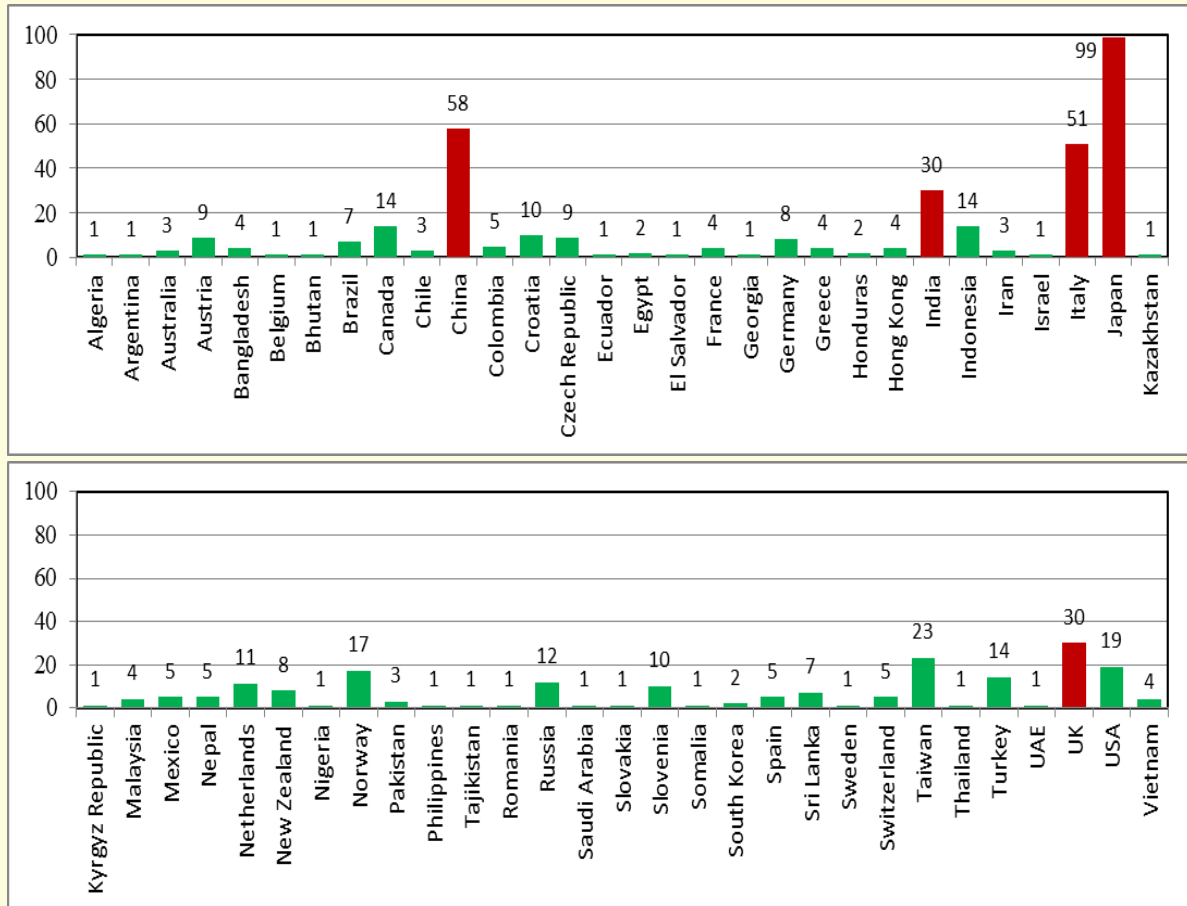


Call for Speakers and E-Poster Presenters of WLF5

547 Registered Speakers from 59 Countries (as of 20 November 2019)



Registered speakers:

WLF5 has called to register as speakers for papers published in one of three publication types: Thematic issue of Landslides Journal, 9 themes/volumes of full color books, and Electronic Proceedings (Abstract + PPT) through preliminary registration page. 547 individuals from 59 countries have registered and selected publication type through WLF5 WEB <<http://wlf5.iplhq.org/preliminary-registration/>>.

Call for electronic poster presenters:

After receiving various requests from registered participants and visitors to the WLF5 web, we have created the electronic poster presentation (e-poster) as the fourth publication type. E-posters will be reviewed by the editorial board of posters session. The accepted e-poster will be published in the WLF5 web, available to download by registered participants and to cite as its number. E-poster session will be scheduled in the Forum programme, and the authors can choose to have a short (3 minutes) oral presentation or not to attend the Forum. Speakers of full papers may also publish and present their posters in addition to full papers with additional poster publication fee of 26,000 JPY/poster. Registration for the first e-poster presentation is the same with the regular speakers. The deadline of submission of e-posters is 31 July 2020.
