1st day in Hiroshima (7 Nov. 2020)

Start from Kyoto to Hiroshima by Shinkansen

- Urban landslide disasters triggered by local extreme rainfalls in 2014 and 2018
- World Cultural Heritage “Itsukushima Shrine”, and Sabo works in the heritage area
- Hiroshima Peace Memorial Park (Stay in Hiroshima)

2nd day in Unzen (8 Nov. 2020)

From Hiroshima to Kumamoto by Shinkansen and to Unzen by ferry

- 1792 Unzen-Mayuyama mega-slide by an earthquake and caused Tsunami disaster
- Unzen Volcanic Area Global Geopark, Unzen Disaster
- Mount Unzen Disaster Memorial Hall (Stay in Unzen Hot Spring)

3rd day (9 Nov. 2020)

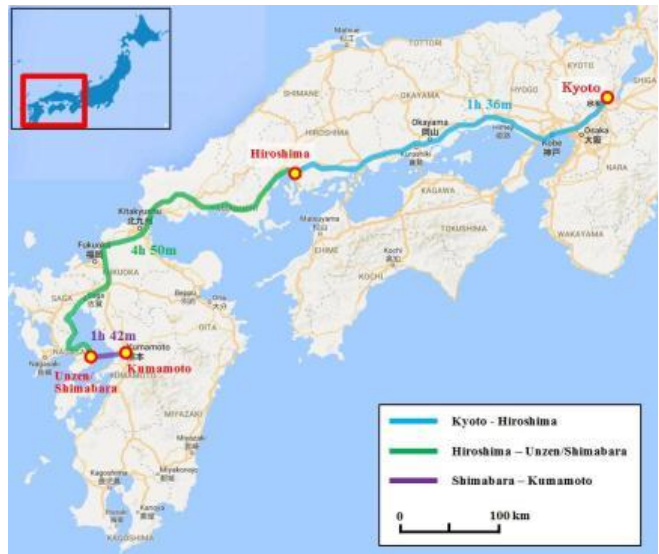
From Unzen Hot Spring to the Shimabara port by bus, to Kumamoto by ferry, and to Aso Caldera by bus

- Observation of the mega-slide from a ferry
- Landslides induced by Kumamoto Earthquake in Aso Caldera in 2016
- Leave Kumamoto station to Osaka by railway, or Kumamoto airport to Osaka/Tokyo by air.
